She showed us the basics of lunging and long lining with different equipment (the true value of baling twine!) and different animals. Of course she made doing figure 8's on the long lines look SOOOO easy! After her demonstrations we went back to the trailers to get our horses to bring them up to the dressage arena to practice what we just learned. If we didn't bring a horse Barbie had Justice & Hannah for us to work with. Bev & Penny got some great shots of everyone working

After we worked in the dressage arena we came back to the trailers and

had lunch. After lunch we went over to the nicely shaded tree area where 2 rein boards & chairs were set up. Barbie explained the use of rein boards and showed us various ways of holding reins.



She also let the rein board shows us how dramatically we "drop" our horses when we reach up to

adjust our glasses, wave to a neighbor or when we use our whips. It was a great clinic and everyone was VERY attentive in all phases of demonstrations. THANK YOU Barbie and the Paradox team for hosting this clinic. Barbie I have already had a request for a repeat clinic!
